### ARTICLE TITLE

### Abstract [Times New Roman, 10 pt, Bold]

The text of the abstract is written in the original language [Times New Roman, 10 pt.] The text should contain no more than 500 characters. The abstract should give a brief overview of the content of the article, the relevance of the problem and the study, the methods used in the study, and the obtained findings.

Key words: 3-5 words expressing the main features of the theme [Times New Roman, 10 pt]

### Introduction [Times New Roman, 11 pt, Bold]

The text of the introduction [Times New Roman, 11 pt] should be arranged in one column. Line spacing is 1 (single), both-sided alignment should be used. Paragraphs begin with a new line, indented 1 cm.

### Headings and sub-headings [Times New Roman, 11 pt, Bold]

The body of the article should be single-spaced [Times New Roman, 11 pt]. Line spacing is 1 (single) and both-sided alignment should be used. Paragraphs begin with a new line, indented 1 cm. Page margins: top 2,0 cm, bottom 2 cm, left 3 cm, right 2 cm.

Tables should be numbered and have titles. The table number and title should be written above the table, centred, the title should be written in bold.

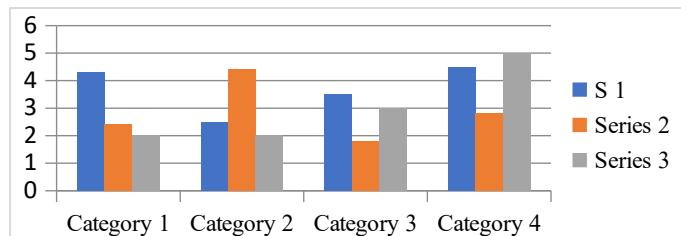


Figure 1. **Figure title [Times New Roman, 11 pt]**
